Paper length is at most six pages (can be extended up to eight pages but subject to an additional fee) in IEEE style including results, figures, and references. Full papers will be rigorously and competitively peer reviewed. All accepted full papers will be published in the conference proceedings and archived in IEEE Xplore subject to the approval of IEEE. We also plan to plan to organize special issues in Fuzzy Sets and Systems (Elsevier), International Journal of Approximate Reasoning (Elsevier), Journal of Advanced Computational Intelligence and Intelligent Informatics (Fuji Technology Press).

#### ■ Position Papers

Position papers are expected to present a proposal about an issue, without the need of presenting full research and/or experimental results. Paper length is at most four pages. All position papers will be published in the conference proceedings (not archived in IEEE Xplore).
